

## **Abstract Submission Instructions**

Abstract submissions are accepted only electronically by using the online submission system. The abstract submission will close on **April 27, 2026**.

Each author can **submit a maximum of three abstracts in total (research abstract or case report)**.

Accepted contributions will be presented either as oral or poster presentations, according to the final decision by the Scientific Committee. Acceptance of the abstract is subject to acceptance by the Scientific Committee, and the Committee has all rights to accept or reject the abstract. The acceptance letters will be sent by **June 15, 2026** (subject to changes).

All accepted abstracts will be published at the conference, subject to the author registering as a paid delegate. The accepted abstracts will be published as typed by the author, including any errors in grammar, spelling or scientific facts.

## Instructions for Abstract Submission

### **Language**

All abstracts must be written in English.

### **Title**

The title should be typed in Sentence case and should not exceed 15 words. Do NOT type the full title in capital letters.

The title should be specific, descriptive, and avoid using abbreviations unless they are widely known. It should clearly indicate the main topic and, if possible, the results or unique aspect of the study.

### **Presentation type**

Select the preferred presentation type; oral or poster, or either one. The selection is only your preference, and the Scientific Committee has the right to change it.

## **Theme**

Select a suitable theme for your research abstract or case report:

1. Diving medicine
2. Hyperbaric medicine
3. Freediving
4. Miscellaneous

## **Authors and Affiliations**

Please fill in the author details as requested on the form. Kindly mark only **one author as the presenter**. The first author's name should be the name of the presenter.

## **Body of the abstract**

The maximum size of the **abstract is 350 words**. The 350-word limit does not include the title or author details of the abstract; the limit is for the actual text of the abstract.

The body of the abstract should be structured as follows:

### **> For Research Abstracts**

- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

### **> For Case Reports**

- Case description
- Conclusion

One table or graph may be included (jpeg. or gif. format).

## **Terms and conditions**

In submitting an abstract all presenters agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1- I confirm that each author / presenter listed agree with the content of this abstract and has given permission to be listed as an author / presenter.
- 2- I have checked the accuracy of the information and referencing within this abstract.
- 3- I understand that should my abstract be accepted for presentation, I am required to complete a conference registration. I understand that my abstract will not be published until my registration and full payment has been received.
- 4- I hereby provide permission for the Organisers and Committee of the Conference to

publish my abstract in the Conference proceedings.

5- I understand that my abstract will be published, if accepted, as submitted and that no editing to grammar or spelling will be undertaken by the Organizing Committee.

### **Submission process**

1. Log in to the abstract submission page [here](#). If you have created an account, please use your password. If you are logging in for the first time, please select the **Create Profile**–option. Kindly note that only abstracts submitted using the online system can be accepted.

2. Select **Submit Abstract**

3. Select **New Submission** either in the research abstract submission or case report submission section.

4. Fill in the requested details:

1. Preferred Presentation Type
2. Themes
3. Title (according to the instructions given)
4. Abstract text and upload a picture of graph, if you wish
5. Conflict of Interest
6. Add author & affiliation details
7. Review and accept all terms & conditions
8. Review your abstract submission
9. Click on **Submit** and you will receive a confirmation email

At any time in the process you can click the **Save** button to save your incomplete submission and continue it at a later moment. You can edit the draft version or the submitted version of your abstract until the submission deadline **April 27, 2026**.
